New Street Sweeper and Its Operator

The City of Live Oak is dedicated to the health of its residents and wildlife. We take immense pride in keeping our city streets clear of debris, hazardous materials, and chemicals that can be consumed by wildlife or can run off into our waterways killing fish and other aquatic life.

Recognizing that street sweepers are imperative to environmental quality, we made sure to purchase the best of the best when the time came to replace our old street sweeper. After a two year long wait, our new street sweeper has finally arrived. The Elgin Whirlwind1™ is an environmentally clean machine boasting a leak free hydraulic system, ergonomic controls, an effective extension broom, side brooms that follow the road contours, and a pure vacuum with the highest possible containment removal rate with superior dust suppression.

The driver of our street sweeper, David Abbott, is trained in the safe operation of this machine. He has experience operating various equipment in Public Works and has operated the sweeper for the City of Live Oak since 2006. With over 28 years of service with the City of Live Oak, 18 of that behind the wheel of the sweeper, David has learned to maneuver around obstacles while staying as close to the curbs as possible to safely and effectively clean the streets of Live Oak.

David followed in his father's footsteps and served in the United States Air Force until 1988. An avid Boston Red Sox fan, David spends his spare time rooting for his favorite baseball team, spending time with his wife of 28 years, Diana, and keeping in touch with his four children and four grandchildren. David's mother, Bernadette, has been a resident of Live Oak for over 50 years. David spends his lunch break with his mother every day and credits her love and support along with his Christian beliefs for his successes. Although he has visited many places around the United States with the Air Force, he planted his roots near his mother. We are proud to have him as a member of the Public Works Department for the City of Live Oak.





Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) Drone Program

Live Oak Police Department is excited to implement its own unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) program. UAVs will be used by Live Oak Police Department to enhance public safety and improve efficiency in policing operations. Live Oak's drone program also offers a cost-effective and time-efficient solution for tasks such as search and rescue operations where officers can cover larger areas in a shorter amount of time, leading to faster response times and more effective outcomes.

"The goal of the addition of drones to our department is to enhance the efficiency and safety of our officers. Drones can provide aerial views in real-time, aiding in search and rescue operations and tracking suspects. In the brief time that we have had our drones, they have already proven to be invaluable for us and in our collaborative efforts with the fire department and neighboring municipalities," states Chief Gary Hopper.

Currently, Live Oak has two UAV operators, Sergeant Caesar DeHoyos and Officer Jeffrey Trigg. Both officers have obtained a Remote Pilot Certificate from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA).

Safety First

Summer is upon us in Texas, and July is one of the HOTTEST months of the year. Be prepared for the excessive EXTREME HEAT, which often results in the highest annual number of deaths among all weather-related disasters.

Here are some tips for an extreme heat warning:

- Find a cool spot or air conditioning, if possible.
- Avoid strenuous activities.
- Watch for heat illness.
- Check on family members and neighbors.
- Drink plenty of fluids.
- Watch for heat cramps, heat exhaustion, and heat stroke.
- NEVER leave people or pets in a closed car.

Outdoor Grilling Safety

- Only use your grill outside and keep it at least 10 feet from your home.
- Keep a 3-foot safe zone around your grill.
- Keep an eye on your grill or fire pit.
- **DO NOT WALK AWAY FROM THEM WHEN THEY ARE LIT**
- Clean your grill after each use to remove grease that can start a fire.
- Place the hot coals from your grill in a metal can with a lid **ONCE IT HAS COOLED.**

The Live Oak Fire Department and Police Department would like to remind everyone of the City Ordinance regarding fireworks (see below). Leave the fireworks to the professionals and visit a safe, professional fireworks show.

Chapter 8. Article III. Sec 8-43 Prohibited

Make sure your grill is on a flat, stable surface. Use a grill pad or splatter mat under grill if cooking on a deck.

Remove grease build-up from the grill grates and drip tray. For charcoal grills, make sure the coals are cold before disposing in a metal container.

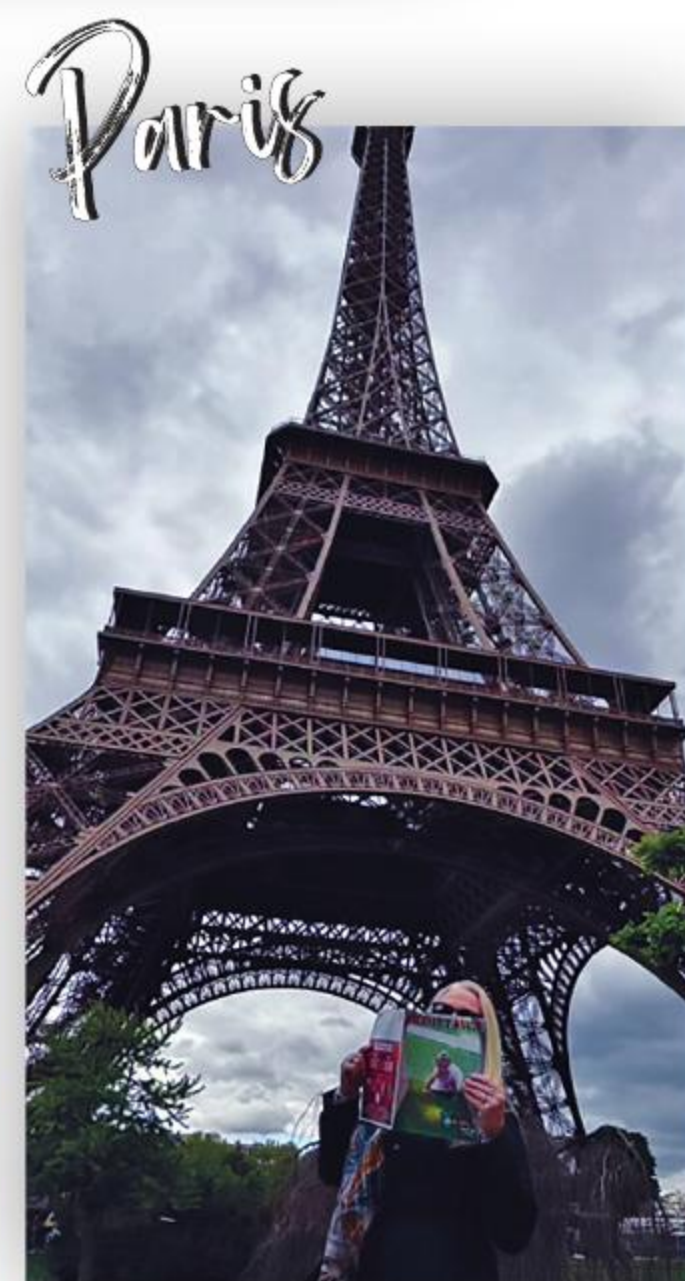

DON'T LET A HEATED SURFACE HARM YOUR PET'S PAWS

Keep Your Animals Safe In The Heat

We all love spending the long, sunny days of summer outdoors with our furry companions, but being overeager in hot weather can spell danger. To prevent your pet from overheating, take these simple precautions to keep your pets safe:

Walk your pets during the early morning hours or the late evening hours to avoid hot asphalt temperatures. Paw damage can happen in 60 seconds. The City parks are ideal for shady walks on one of the trail paths.

Know the symptoms of overheating in pets

- Excessive panting/difficulty breathing
- Increased heart and respiratory rate
- Drooling, mild weakness, stupor or even collapse.
- Symptoms can also include seizures, bloody diarrhea and vomit
- Elevated body temperature of over 104 degrees.

Never leave your animals in a parked vehicle.

Pets can dehydrate quickly, so give them plenty of fresh, clean water and make sure they have a shady place to get out of the sun. Always have water with you during walks for you and your pet.

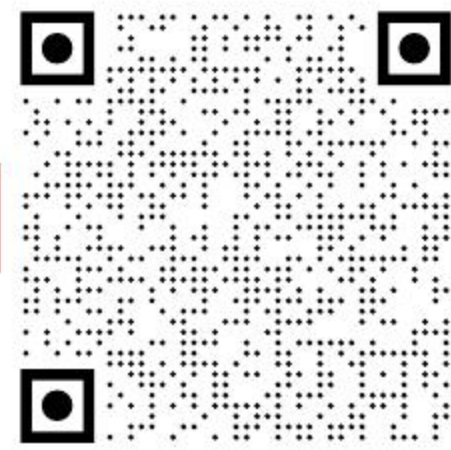


Making a Home Fire Escape Plan

Pull together everyone in your household and make a Fire Escape Plan. Walk through your home and inspect all possible exits and escape routes. Residents usually have less than 2 minutes to escape a home fire once the smoke alarm sounds.

Here are a few easy steps to create a fire escape plan.

- Draw a floor plan for each floor of your home, including windows and doors. For each room, find two ways out and label them on your plan.
- Designate one adult to help babies, young children, and family members who need extra help getting out safely. Have a back-up plan in case the primary person is overcome by smoke or is not at home.
- Decide on a safe meeting place for your family. Make sure it is a safe distance away from the home.
- Make sure everyone knows what to do and where to go in case of fire.
- Test your smoke alarms twice a year.
- Teach your child to get low and crawl on the ground where the air is less smoky.
- Remember, every second counts. Practice your fire escape plan twice a year.

Watering Rules & Drought Restrictions

San Antonio Water System uses watering rules and restrictions. The City of Live Oak follows the SAWS water restrictions and drought stages that can be found on their website at saws.org. The rules & restrictions limit water use based on specific levels of the Edwards Aquifer. On May 23rd, SAWS board voted to approve the proposal to streamline the enforcement process aiming to hold customers directly accountable for violations of the watering rules. In lieu of citations, violators of the water rules under the new changes would be charged the violation fines directly to customers' bills. If you are a SAWS customer living in Live Oak, you should have received an email notification with details of the changes. For questions about your SAWS bill, please contact Customer Service at 210-704-7297, Monday through Friday (8a-5p) and Saturday (9a-1p) for assistance.

Year-Round Watering Rules

Year-Round watering rules are in effect when the Edwards Aquifer level is above 660 feet mean sea level at the monitored well.

Stage 1 Drought Restrictions

Stage 1 begins when the 10-day rolling average of the aquifer level drops to 660 feet mean sea level at the monitored well. Watering with an irrigation system, sprinkler or soaker hose is allowed only once a week before 11 a.m. or after 7 p.m. on your designated watering day.

Stage 2 Drought Restrictions

Stage 2 begins when the 10-day rolling average of the aquifer level drops to 650 feet mean sea level at the monitored well. Watering with an irrigation system or sprinkler is allowed only once a week from 7-11 a.m. and 7-11 p.m.

Stage 3 Drought Restrictions

Stage 3 begins when the 10-day rolling average of the aquifer level drops to 640 feet mean sea level at the monitored well. Landscape watering is allowed only EVERY OTHER WEEK, from 7-11 a.m. and 7-11 p.m.

Stage 4 Drought Restrictions

Stage 4 restrictions may be declared at the discretion of the San Antonio City Manager upon completion of a 30-day monitoring period following Stage 3 declaration.

During drought restrictions, watering is allowed on your designated watering day as determined by the last number of your street address.

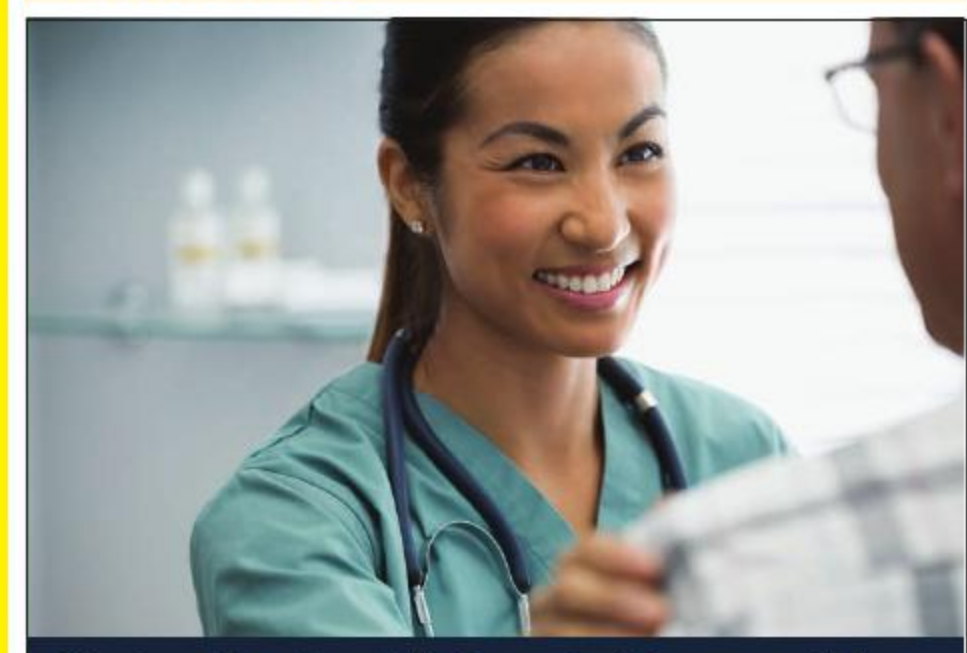




