The City Council and I join together in congratulating Brigadier Pringle with her new endeavors.

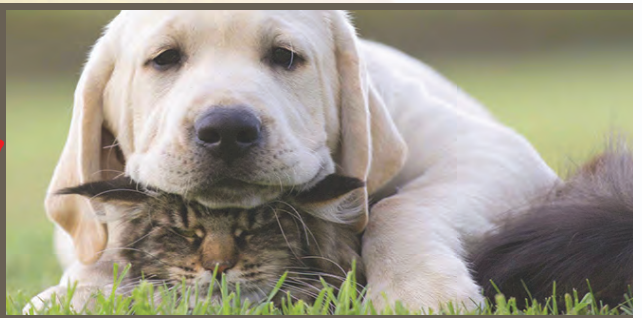

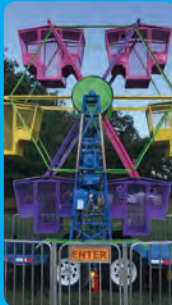

When emergency personnel arrive at a medical emergency, it is vital to have the most accurate medical history on the patient. The Live Oak fire department and our ambulance provider Schertz EMS have teamed up with a program called "File of Life" to ensure that residents receive the care when it matters most in an emergency that they may not be able to speak for themselves.

File of Life is easy for patients to use and recognized by EMTs and first responders. The system is designed to provide medical information, allergies and a list of medications to care takers and first responders. By placing

the File of Life pocket magnet on your refrigerator, it will provide critical medical history necessary for first responders to provide the proper treatment to the patient.

September the 28, 29 and 30th are the scheduled days for the next community city wide garage sale. This is an extra time, provided by the city, to clean out, earn a little extra cash, and tidy up our homes and properties. Monday, October 1st, following our community garage sale, the city provides curbside service to pick up any unwanted items you were not

successful in selling or just want to get rid of. This is a good time to do home repairs such as new fencing or pulling down tired small structures such as old decks that need to be discarded and/or replaced. The items and material you would like to discard should be out on the curb by 6 a.m. Monday morning October 1st. The streets will only be serviced once with this free pick-up so don't wait to get your items out. Please be mindful

that the items you set out for pickup must be placed in an orderly fashion and not to block the city sidewalks or your U.S. Postal mail receptacle. Utility workers will need to be able to read the water meters, so please be careful not to cover them with the debris. Please also be mindful of not blocking any line of vision for traffic with your debris and avoid parking any vehicles on the street near the discarded items. *Waste Management will NOT pick up items such as televisions, batteries, oil, paints or any hazardous materials. Please check Waste Management's web site for a complete list of items they will NOT pick up.*

Information needed: Street address, dates, hours, and main items for sale (i.e. TV, Children's toys, dresser, etc.).

Place your large, unwanted "treasures" near the curb by Sunday evening, September 30th for Bulk Pick Up. The following list of items will not be picked up:

- No tires, household chemicals, paint, oil or batteries
- No electronics such as Televisions, Computers, Computer Monitors and similar items.
- No appliances with Freon such as refrigerators, freezers, or window units.
- No Brush (brush will only be collected during brush pick Gold Zone 1st Thursday each month and Green Zone 3rd Thursday of each month).
- No bricks, blocks, concrete or similar construction materials.

Items cannot be placed at the curb before Monday, September 24th. Waste Management will only pass by once and please remember not to cover the sidewalk or water meter with your items.

Watering Trees in a DROUGHT



Don't forget to water your trees during drought conditions. Tree root systems, unlike carrots, typically don't dive downward but instead go outward spreading two to three times wider than the height of the tree and most absorbing roots are in the top foot of soil. Slowly apply water to soak (not drench) the entire area underneath the full span of a tree's canopy/branches. A damp soil that dries for a short period will allow adequate oxygen to permeate the soil. Trees that do not receive water from sprinkler systems or irrigation require additional water.

Applying mulch to trees also helps retain moisture. Just be sure not to have the mulch right next to the base of the tree. Water small and newly planted trees even more frequently, as they have less extensive root systems. You can check soil moisture by using a garden trowel and inserting it into the ground to a depth of 2", and then move the blade of the trowel back and forth to create a small narrow trench. Then use your finger to touch the soil. If it is moist to the touch, then they do not need water. A dry, yellow yard means the roots of any trees present are also dry.

KNOW YOUR FLOOD RISK

We are fortunate this year to have an abundance of rainfall; however, our area is prone to flash flooding. The State of Texas leads the nation in flood-related fatalities. The first step in preventing flood-related fatalities and the damages caused by flooding is knowing your flood risk.

In 2004, Live Oak joined The Bexar Regional Watershed Management (BRWM) partners – Bexar County, the City of San Antonio, the San Antonio River Authority and 20 suburban cities in Bexar County. As funding partners, we undertook a comprehensive effort to update the County's flood risk maps which resulted in a more accurate depiction of the flood risk in Bexar County. In addition to converting the maps to a digital format, the BRWM updated flood studies and re-mapped many areas of the floodplain that had not been mapped since the 1970's.

In March 2010, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) approved the new Digital Flood Insurance Rate Maps for Bexar County. That means the floodplain maps for your area might have changed based on these more up-to-date flood studies.

Live Oak has since updated the city's existing flood ordinance. If you haven't done so, please log on to www.bexarfloodfacts.org and check the new flood maps to determine how the changes may impact our city and your property. If your property is near a drainage ditch or stream, please help do your part by keeping the area free of brush and debris. If you have any questions about the floodplain on your property, please call City Manager, Scott Wayman, at 210-653-9140, ext. 2261. We will come out to your property and help answer any flood related concerns or questions you may have.

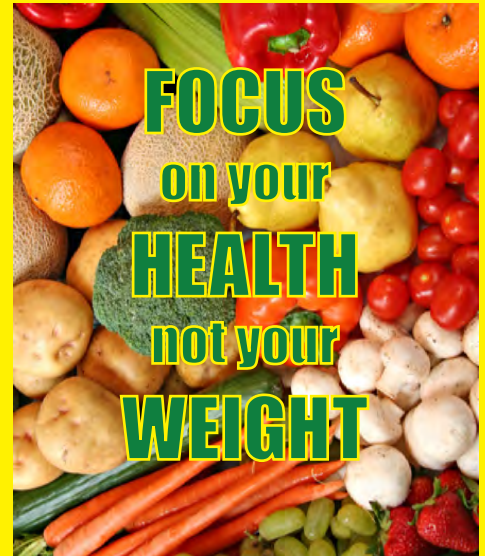
